*"Stress assignment in reading words in normal readers and dyslexic patients with left hemisphere damage"* liaised with the University of Pavia, University of Milan Bicocca and Maugeri Foundation Hospital in Pavia.  
 Thesis Directors: Prof. Alessio Toraldo and Prof. Gabriella Bottini  
 The project derived from Max Coltheart' studies on English linguistic processing and had the aim to analyse the specific process of stress assignment in reading words and non-words (invented words without a specific stress assignment). The study presented data on two experiments. The first one concerned a sample of 27 Italian normal readers who participated in a reading task including words and non-words (880 items overall). Results showed that stress assignment is influenced by lexical information even when the material is non-lexical (non-words). In the second experiment, five Italian dyslexic patients with left hemisphere damage participated in two different tasks: a reading task including words and non-words (a total of 124 items) and a picture naming task (51 pictures). Results showed a simple dissociation between stress assignment and phonological assignment. This result is consistent with the idea that phonology is at least partially extracted via grapheme-to-phoneme conversion while stress extraction involves partial activation of the lexical route.
